MCA vs. Joseph Baird

On Monday, August 3, 2020, a Circuit Judge in Hillsborough County denied Joe Baird's motion to dismiss. After she listened to both sides during a hearing in May as well as being provided pertinent documents and affidavits, she determined there was enough evidence to send this case to a jury trial. The Judge also stated that MCA is entitled to recover attorney's fees. This is great news for MCA, and we want to thank our legal team for their hard work and look forward to seeing this through and ensuring justice for MCA.

MCA vs. CCPS

On July 8, 2020 MCA dropped their suit against MCA, because MCA accomplished its goals through the modification of the charter by the CCPS Board. This lawsuit would not have happened had it not been for CCPS continuing to make an issue about Hillsdale College and MCA's Charter with CCPS.
